Mission - The Kids-Safe Identification Program is designed to provide an easy way for parents to ensure that accurate information is readily available to parents and law enforcement agencies in the event that a child is lost or abducted.

How It Works - Your child is photographed with a digital camera, their fingerprint captured and personal data is entered into the system. The plastic driver's license style Kids-Safe ID card is produced and given to the parent. If the parent wishes, information can be saved to a secure database for a period of time in the event that the card is lost and the information is needed.

Privacy & Safety - Without exception, no images and/or data are available to anyone outside appropriate law enforcement and only for emergency needs!
